The University of New Mexico Children's Campus (UNMCC) is the sole childcare provider for UNM's Main and North Campuses, serving a diverse community of children aged 6 weeks to 12 years. As a NAEYC-accredited, 5-star facility, it's a hub for campus life, connecting students, staff, faculty, and the UNMH and HSC. With a capacity for 271 children, it offers various care options and is funded by student fees, grants, and the Division of Student Affairs. It also serves as a research and practicum site for UNM students and faculty.
