

# VETERAN'S AND MILITARY RESOURCE CENTER WHAT WE DO FOR STUDENTS


### WHO WE ARE

The VMRC is the liaison between the veteran and military-affiliated community to UNM as a whole, as well as the vast network of external veteran entities such as the Department of Veterans Affairs and the New Mexico Department of Veterans Services. The VMRC works hand-in-hand with other UNM resources to ensure that military-affiliated students receive the support they need to succeed academically, personally, and professionally.

Embedded mental health counselor serves the military-affiliated student population, giving them a space they feel safe in, in an environment they are comfortable visiting. Peer Advising for Veteran Education

(PAVE) program matches up military-affiliated mentors with military-affiliated mentees to offer academic and personal support to help with transitioning from military to academics and life after academics.
