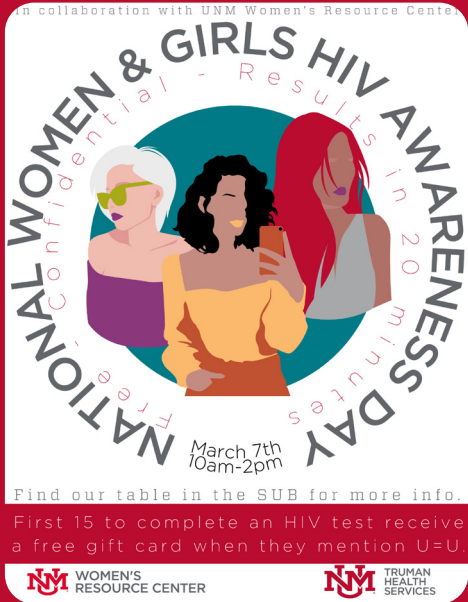

- Must have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Must display financial need
