Residents must maintain eligibility to live in UNM housing, and fulfill their 2022-2023 housing license agreement for the entire agreement period. If a resident breaks their license agreement the \$200 and prize will be forfeited. (Exceptions: graduation or military activation) Award drawing will take place after Priority Renewal closes.

Students currently living on campus who are planning to live on campus for 2022-2023 are highly encouraged to complete their housing renewal by March 11. Students who renew have the opportunity to pick their room first, will get a \$200 credit towards their fall semester housing charges, and are entered into a drawing to win a credit of up to \$1000 towards their fall housing charges!
