Join us for a variety of exciting two-week, full-day, camp sessions for children ages 10 through 12 (children must have completed 6th grade to be eligible to participate)! We are a licensed 5-star facility that is nationally recognized and accredited through the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). Camps run each day from 8:30am to 4:30pm with before and after camp care available for an additional fee. Breakfast, Lunch, and an afternoon snack are included in the program fee. All campers receive a camp t-shirt, hat, and water bottle, and are eligible to participate in an overnight campout at the end of each two-week camp.

Session 1: June 1st-June 12th

High Tide and Shore Side

Campers will kayak along the Rio Grande, cool off at Santa Rosa's Park Lake, slip and slide at Cliff's Water Mania, ride the waves at Hotel Cascada, enjoy the soothing waters of Cochiti Lake, have fun fishing at Shady Lakes, take a trip to the Genoveva Chavez Community Center, meet the water creatures at Albuquerque's Aquarium, and camp-out at Nambe Falls.

Session 2: June 15th-June 26th

Let the Games Begin

Campers will play their way through the last two weeks of June. Train at the Athlete's Playground, bike along the Bosque, get fit at CrossFit Black Box, learn the art of Parkour, spend the night inside Stone Age Climbing Gym, and partake in a variety of activities such as swimming, bowling, gymnastics, yoga, and golfing.

Intersession: June 29th, 30th, July 1st & 2nd FUNKY FIESTA WEEK

During the four intersession days, campers will have fun bowling, playing Laser Tag, roller skating and swimming. Campers can also participate in Funky Fiesta Week's Funky Fiesta Dress Days which include inside-outfit day, funky hair day, funny hat day, and pajama day.
