WHO WE ARE

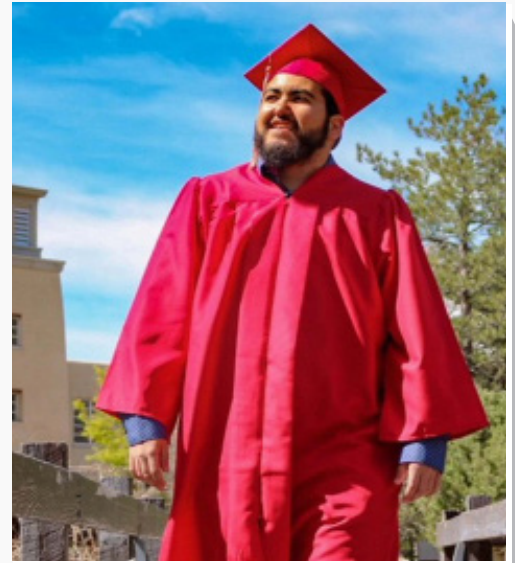
